

INGREDIENTS:

LAYERED MINT SQUARES

½ cup baking cocoa
½ cup confectioners' sugar
l egg, beaten
l teaspoon vanilla extract
cups graham cracker crumbs
½ cup (l stick) butter
l/3 cup whipping cream
l/8 teaspoon LorAnn Peppermint Oil
cups confectioners' sugar
¼ cup (l/2 stick) butter



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Combine $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter and the baking cocoa in a 2-quart saucepan. Heat until the butter melts, stirring frequently.
- 2. Remove from heat and stir in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup confectioners' sugar, egg and vanilla; stir in graham crackers crumbs.
- 3. Press into the bottom of a greased 9" x 13" baking pan. Set aside.
- 4. Melt ½ cup butter in a small saucepan. Pour into a non-plastic mixing bowl and add cream and peppermint.
- 5. With an electric mixer on low speed, beat in 3 cups confectioners' sugar until smooth.
- 6. Spread mint mixture over graham cracker layer.
- 7. Chill for 30 minutes.
- 8. Melt $\frac{1}{4}$ cup butter and the chocolate chips in a saucepan over low heat.
- 9. Spread chocolate mixture over the mint layer.
- 10. Chill, covered for 1 to 2 hours. Cut into small squares.

Keep refrigerated until ready to serve. Makes 30 servings
